Hi Curtis,

Below is our new process for submitting a request to obtain copyright permission. The more information about the video(s) you can send Tom, the better. Since you have already communicated with the copyright holder, you should also mention that and to whom you spoke.

Also, please let Tom know what class you'll be using the video for, how often you'll be using it, and/or whether it will be used department-wide.

- Faculty should send an email to Tom Ipri, the Library's Head of Media and Computer Services, < tom.ipri@unlv.edu> with a request for the desired videos, including their call numbers and anything else he would need to research their distributors, and the time period for the requested videos.
- Tom forwards the video request and distributor information to Chris Duke, Distance Ed's Interactive Applications Coordinator, who will prepare the video copyright permission request form.
- Mark Fink, Distance Ed's acting director, signs and transmits the permission request.
- When the distributor responds, Mark alerts the faculty member, Tom, and the DE staff.

We anticipate the distributor response time and answer to vary widely. Requests should be made as early as possible.
